Weigh in: 3:00PM – 4:00PM At South Shore launch ramp

Location: Any waters you can reach and make it back in time for the weigh in

Species: California Halibut

Price: \$20.00 per angler for members  
\$25.00 per nonmember (guests)

Junior Angler: Fish for free, \$25.00 gift card for 1<sup>st</sup> place, \$15.00 gift card for 2<sup>nd</sup> place and \$10.00 gift card for 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

Guests: All guests may fish 2 tournaments without being a member as long as they are fishing on a member's boat or have a member with them on their boat.  
**ALL PERSONS AND GUESTS ON EVERY BOAT MUST BE ENTERED INTO THE TOURNAMENT**

Tournament Rules: The three largest Halibut will determine the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners

Sports Points: Each Angler's single largest fish will go to determining the sports points. The top three heaviest fish will receive 5 points for 1<sup>st</sup>, 4 points for 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3 points for 3<sup>rd</sup> respectively in Men's, Women's and Juniors.

Side Pot: Largest Bass. Cost: \$10.00 All Angler's per boat must be entered in the side pot to win.

Weigh Master: (Curt Itogawa) Any and all protests must be made at the scale during the weighing of any fish. All ties will go to the Angler who weighed in first. Final time is determined by the weigh master's watch. Any questions, call Curt at 760-791-7225.

Tournament Master: (Kirk Johnson) May call off any tournament due to small craft warnings or postpone at his discretion. Any questions, call Kirk 858-354-2997.

You must notify Kirk by 8:00PM on October 13<sup>th</sup> if you are fishing and with whom, as well as if you are in the side pot. Any Angler who notifies the club they are fishing will be expected to pay the appropriate fees at the weigh in.
